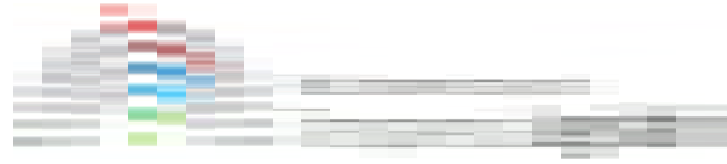

DECLARATION ON PARLIAMENTARY OPENNESS

Revised Commentary

Opening a Culture of Openness

Empowering Public Oversight of Parliament's Activities

- 1. The Commission on the Reform of the Parliament of the Republic of Serbia (the Commission) has been entrusted with the task of reviewing the activities of the Parliament of the Republic of Serbia (the Parliament) and to propose measures to improve its transparency and accountability to the public.

The Commission believes that the current level of transparency and accountability of the Parliament is insufficient and that the public has a right to know how the Parliament spends public funds and how it exercises its powers. The Commission has identified several areas where the Parliament's activities are not fully transparent and where the public has limited access to information. These areas include the Parliament's budget, its procurement processes, its staffing and personnel, its operations, and its decision-making processes. The Commission proposes a number of measures to improve the Parliament's transparency and accountability, including the establishment of a Public Access Portal, the implementation of a Freedom of Information Act, and the introduction of a Public Petition System. The Commission believes that these measures will help to ensure that the Parliament is open to public scrutiny and that its activities are conducted in a transparent and accountable manner.

The Commission also proposes that the Parliament should be required to publish its budget and to provide a detailed breakdown of its expenditures. The Commission believes that this will help to ensure that the public can see how the Parliament spends public funds and that it can hold the Parliament accountable for its actions.
